It's time to register for Summer CCD!

This year will be different—but change is good and maybe it's time to adapt Summer CCD to a new schedule. Summer CCD is open to everyone in Grades 3-6. There will be a Fall Program!!! Summer is just an option. However, there are no classroom limitations and we have no idea how the Fall Schedule will look. It might be easier for everyone to complete CCD Faith Formation now! So here goes and hopefully the Holy Spirit will push us all in the right direction!

The Catechist, student book, and all assignments are online. Our publisher, Sadlier, was working on a virtual component and it all became available—just in time!!! I am still the administrator over Grades 3 and 6. Cathy will do grades 4 and 5.

This is how we will proceed:

1. There will be a parent Zoom class to explain the eBook and all its components. We will give you ideas on how to run your class. We will explain the assignments that the CCD Office will assign each grade. All work is due by August 3.

2. Cathy and I will run the first zoom class for the students for each grade. We then ask you to partner to run one class. Each class will only last 40 minutes, and you will cover 1 lesson with 1 lesson assigned. There will be 2 zoom classes a week for 5 weeks. We will begin on June 22 and be done with zoom classes by July 24. We can discuss at our parent zoom class best time for class zoom and we are thinking Mondays and Thursdays for our days of week.
